City Reorganizes Operations in Preparation for Community Development Director's Retirement

In anticipation of the August 2021 retirement of Grant Beck, an invaluable long-standing employee who serves as both the our Community Development Director and IT Director, the City of Yelm evaluated and implemented organizational changes. As a result of the ongoing analyis



of Department Directors and the conversations they have been having with employees, several departments will be better integrated and aligned to help fill the big gap Grant will leave behind, while also building on the city's ongoing efforts to improve customer service and operational efficiency.

To better integrate our confidential systems and access requirements of information technology, the IT Department has been combined with Human Resources to form a new Administrative Services Department, which will be led by Lori Lucas. To better serve businesses applying for permits and integrate the planning and construction of essential infrastructure, the Community Development Department has been combined with the Public Works Department to form a new Public Services Department, which will be led by Cody Colt. To continue collectively providing support to all departments and exceptional customer service to residents and businesses as our most forward facing team, the Communications Specialist has been added to the Customer Service Team to form a new Community Services Department led by Kathy Linnemeyer.
