Skillings Connolly, the engineer who originally designed Cochrane Park more than 20 years ago, has provided a scope of work for modifications and restoration of the existing water ponds and wetlands at the park. A meeting was held in January regarding water rights and how they may affect the overall function of Cochrane Park. This meeting brought together consultants and contractors to discuss the scope of work and to decide who would be working on various studies related the proposed modifications. This project is now intertwined with the City's water rights acquisition efforts to mitigate for potential impacts to Yelm Creek.
